



An opening is available for a full time **Broadband Technician IV**. This role will be hired at Consolidated Business Services (CBS) for a position at Beaver Creek Cooperative Telephone exchange.

The primary purpose of this position is: Performs field technical work. Primarily responsible for maintaining the HFC plant from node to tap through routine maintenance and repair of CATV distribution system and installation and turn-up of new distribution systems. Maintenance and troubleshoot the Fiber and trunk system due to equipment and/or power failure.

Qualifications:

- The ideal candidate will have 3-5 years previous experience as a Broadband Technician IV.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Excellent listening, written, and verbal communication skills.
- Knowledge of RF, troubleshooting; sweep & balance HFC plant, troubleshooting and repair of the coaxial and fiber distribution system.
- Skilled in use of hand and power tools and equipment.
- Ability to work; on-call rotation, flexible work hours, including evenings, weekends, holidays, and overtime as required. Work collaboratively in a team environment with a spirit of cooperation.
- Must be able to frequent handling of heavy objects (approx. 50-100 lbs.), work in high or tight spaces as well as work in all weather conditions.
- Must possess a valid driver's license with a good driving record.

JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conducts system tests such as signal/noise, signal/hum, summation sweep, chart recording, return loss bridge, including monthly, semi-annual, and annual tests; RF knowledge/troubleshooting; sweep & balance HFC plant.
- Sets trunk levels, sets-up and changes out trunk amplifiers, calculates signal level losses in cable and equipment for trunk lines and distribution lines.
- Installs electronics and makes low voltage power connections; maintain power supplies.
- Properly uses, stores, and maintains all test equipment used in system.
- Assumes full responsibility for troubleshooting and repair of the coaxial and fiber distribution system. Prepares estimates for projects, providing bill of materials.
- Works with connectors, fasteners and wire and uses hand tools, splices coax & fiber.
- May perform all duties of Broadband Specialist I-III, Technical Operations descriptions.



- Climb poles with proper equipment (safety belt, safety strap and climbers), ladders or other structures as needed. Lifts and carries loads up to 75lbs (including line ladder); Works within limited confines, such as crawl spaces.
- Performs other duties such as clean-up and salvage of wrecked out materials; provides general assistance to other employees as directed.
- Performs all work related to pole transfers and framing hardware on power poles to meet NEC compliance.
- Performs other job duties and responsibilities a required to fulfill job functions as assigned.
