- Performs a variety of installations, maintenance, and repair work on ADSL, VDSL, FTTx and Cable TV Broadband Network.

- Provides on-site installation, maintenance, troubleshooting, and repair of customer wired and wireless Local Area Network (LAN) equipment, including connectivity of supported computers, switches, routers, servers, tablets/smartphones, peripherals, consumer electronic devices.
- Receives and prioritizes all service orders by date and type of order. Determines work functions to complete the request.



- Conducts system tests such as signal/noise, signal/hum, summation sweep, chart recording, return loss bridge, including monthly, semi-annual, and annual tests; RF knowledge/troubleshooting; sweep & balance HFC plant.
- Operation of aerial bucket truck and climb poles with proper equipment (safety belt, safety strap and climbers), ladders or other structures as needed.
